KCE owns 4 dams very close to your home in the King Country.



Did you know...

Did you know...

Our 4 local stations can generate enough electricity to power 3,400,000 light bulbs!

Do you have the *Kiwi Can* programme in your school?

KCE helps children in 9 local schools have fun with Kiwi Can.

Did you know...

Every second, around 38,500 litres of water flows through our dams.

That's enough water to fill up 77,000 500ml water bottles – **every second!**



Did you know...

At any one time, up to 2500 trout come upstream to lay eggs in the protected section of the Kuratau river.



Did you know...

KCE has built special passageways in some of our dams that allow around 500 eels to migrate safely down river each year.



Did you know...

Eels migrate down our rivers to have babies – called elvers. Around 220,000 baby elvers return upriver through our dam passageways each year.



Did you know...

KCE's oldest local dam, Piriaka, was built in 1924. That's the year before TV was invented!



Did you know...

The electricity generated at KCE dams makes it possible for over 19,000 local homes and businesses to turn their lights on every day.
