

# did you KNOW...?



KCE owns 4 dams very close to your home in the King Country. We also own the Mangahao Power Station near Shannon.



KCE supports the Westpac Rescue Helicopter so it can be available to save lives in the King Country 24 hours a day, 365 days per year.



KCE sponsors Duffy Books in Homes and makes it possible for 540 children each year to receive their own, free books!



KCE sponsors the Otorohanga, Maniapoto and Taumarunui Netball Centres. We help hundreds of girls and boys enjoy netball at these centres each year.



Our 4 local stations can generate enough electricity to power 3,400,000 light bulbs!



Every second, around 38,500 litres of water flows through our dams. That's enough water to fill up 77,000 500ml water bottles – every second!



At any one time, up to 2,500 trout come upstream to lay eggs in the protected section of the Kuratau river.



Eels migrate down our rivers to have babies – called elvers. Around 220,000 elvers return upriver through our dam passageways each year.



KCE has built special passageways in some of our dams that allow around 500 eels to migrate safely down river each year.



KCE's oldest local dam, Piriaka, was built in 1924. That's the year before TV was invented!



The electricity generated at KCE dams makes it possible for over 19,000 local homes and businesses to turn their lights on every day.
